Guide Review - Radney Foster - This World We Live In

Radney Foster is a master songwriter, plain and simple. Chances are if you go through a few of your albums you'll find at least one song he's written. He's written songs recorded by Sara Evans, Dixie Chicks, and even the Kinleys. Now there's a new album of his own to enjoy.
